

Madrasa Contribution – 2009 / 2010

1. The Madrasa contribution for this year is as follows:

Class	Yearly contribution	Notes
Mainstream Class (Non-Hifz)	£330 (Approx. £7.50 per week)	£110 every term
Hifz Class (Includes Ramadhan and Saturdays)	£480 (Approx. £10.40 per week)	£160 every term

2. The Madrasa contribution can be paid in the following manner:

- In one instalment.
- In two instalments.
- In three instalments (the most popular method).
- In more than three instalments (by prior agreement only).
- Please note that we do not collect weekly/fortnightly.*

3. The three terms are as follows:

Term 1	Term 2	Term 3
After Ramadhan Due by Fri 6 th November 2009	After Eid-ul-Adha Due by Fri 18 th December 2009	After the two week April holidays Due by 22 nd May 2010

NOTES:

1. All contributions MUST be submitted in a sealed envelope with your child's FULL name, address and roll number. Please state what term(s) etc is being paid. This is to avoid discrepancies. . If you are paying for more than one child, it is good practice to submit each child's contribution SEPERATELY, otherwise please state clearly what you are enclosing. Please place your envelope in the BLACK box near the office entrance.

DO NOT include ANY other payment (e.g. for books etc) or any other correspondence with the Madrasa contribution.

2. Do note that all receipts are issued within TEN days, and may sometimes take longer (especially just after Ramadhan).

3. If you are paying by CHEQUE, please ensure you make the cheque payable to "Al-Ansaar" AND that you have signed the gift aid form. If you are a UK taxpayer (paying tax at least equal to what will be reclaimed), then on admission you will have filled in a Gift Aid form. If for some reason, you have not filled in a form, please contact the Madrasa office.

4. IMPORTANT: The Madrasa contribution parents pay is *not* a fee (but a donation to the Madrasa). This contribution is a SUBSIDISED amount, so that Islamic education is accessible by all sections of our community. Hence parents who cannot afford to pay even this contribution are given a waiver as per their individual circumstances. Those parents, who wish to pay the NON-SUBSIDISED amount, can certainly do so (and is recommended for all parents whose NET annual household income is over £40k). The non-subsidised amount PER CHILD is based on the annual deficit and pupil numbers of the previous Madrasa year, and is £600 for the year 07 / 08. Please note that NO GIFT AID will be claimed for all such payments.

5. Parents can make a donation of any amount over the annual contribution; this will help us immensely in running the Madrasa. We are a charity, and we do not have any regular income or funding. We solely operate on the donations and support of parents and other individuals.
