Parents' Day & Other Updates

Assalamualaykum, Dear parent,

We hope you are in the best of Iman and health.

To discuss your child's progress, the Madrasa has a parents' day. Although this was scheduled for 1st and 2nd December, we have bought this forward so that you can meet teachers and identify what help / support your child needs from the outset.

The dates for our parents' day is:

Thursday 13 th October - Session 1 & Hifz class Friday 14 th October - Session 2

Important: Reception and Level 1 will be having their parents' day at a later stage (end of November). Reception is yet to start formal learning, and Level 1 are still revising the Reception syllabus and thereafter will start new Sabaq. Thus, teachers will have a better overview of your child after new Sabaq resumes. Thus Reception and Level 1 will attend on both days as normal.

Please note the following in respect to Parents' Day:

- ***There will be NO MADRASA on these two days EXCEPT for Hifz classes who will attend on Friday 14th October (and not on Thu 13th Oct).***
- Teachers will be outside at 6pm and 7.45pm with a time sheet ***FROM Monday 10th Oct.*** Please book an appointment with your child's class teachers. It will be first come first served.
- Remember if your child has two teachers then a separate appointment will have to be made for each teacher.
- On both days, Maghrib Jamaat for men will be at 6.30pm in Rooms 3 and 4.
- Ladies can perform their Salaah in these rooms as well (after the Jamaat).
- Please avoid other queries on the day - the office will be closed.
- ***Please also avoid ringing the Madrasa for appointments, as teachers will have the timesheets.***

Other updates are:

Item Appeal: We thank all parents who have taken part. This really helps us. We are still collecting tissue boxes, air fresheners, toilet rolls, Mr sheen etc. Remember your Madrasa in your weekly shopping.

New admissions: If your child is going to be at least 4 years old by 01/09/12, and you wish to enrol for September 2012, you need to do so by Eid-ul-Adha. Note that Session 1 is already full, and although siblings take priority over all other admissions; you must return the form before the deadline.

Things have changed a lot! So please also read the "Pre-admission Guidelines" that is given out with the form.

Lates and absences: This year, we are taking robust action on this. A small minority of pupils are regular late comers, and with only 1.5 hours of Madrasa you can judge for yourself the impact of this. We will be writing to parents about this, and if necessary we will also take disciplinary action.

Your child needs to be in Madrasa by 4.25 and 6.10pm.

Sabaq issues: Where Surats, Duas, Quran (and Ahsanul Qawaid) are concerned, without sufficient preparation from home, your child cannot perform well in the actual classroom. Thus please ensure there is learning taking place everyday at home. Just 15+ minutes makes a huge difference, and every child can achieve this by efficient supervision (of not wasting time in other aspects).

Currently for L1+ there is revision going on of Duas etc (of previous Levels), thus this is a great opportunity to "catch up" and set a good foundation for the rest of the year.

Term 1 contribution: The sum of £115 per child is now overdue. Help us by paying promptly. If you wish to pay in instalments, this is possible but only by setting up a Standing Order. Visit our website for a form and guidelines.
