Important Updates

Assalamualaykum, Dear parents,

We hope you are in the best of health and Iman. Please note:

1. Police Letter: The letter on the revise is from Inspector O'Neill, he has had several meetings with the Madrasa, and he is asking for all our parents to cooperate. Please read the letter carefully.

2. Road Safety Marshalls: It is quite possible the Police may take this further (see reverse), thus we will need parents as volunteers to become "road Marshalls". If you are interested, please email your full name and contact details to the Madrasa (open to both mothers and fathers). Full training will be given if this goes ahead.

Parents also need to note that there will be costs involved in running a "road Marshall" scheme, mainly liability insurance, safety clothing etc. This cost will unfortunately have to be picked up by parents. If we do not have sufficient volunteers, then it is quite possible we may have to employ someone for the proposed scheme.

3. Grit Box: We have so far raised £250.98, this is enough for the box, however we still require contributions for the rock salt. Please send in your contribution if you still have not done so. Many parents have also passed on various suggestions; we will look into these keeping in mind the needs of the Madrasa.

4. Parents' Day: Reminder: 27th January is for session 1 and 28th Jan for session 2 and all Hifz classes. Time slots will be given from Wednesday 20th January.

5. Poor Weather: There will only be a message on the answering machine if the weather is poor, otherwise please assume there is Madrasa everyday.

6. Absences: Many children are failing to bring in an absence note to Madrasa. Please send in a note each time your child is absent.

7. Learning @ home: Although this maybe taking place at home, due to a combination of factors such as a lack of supervision / concentration and "quality" effort, pupils are bringing in Sabaq which is well below their ability. We request parents to address this and ensure quality time is spent at home for Sabaq (in the morning / after school etc).
