Books to be covered:

1. Use Arabic material in the Level 3 revision booklet.

Arabic writing practice:

Part 1 – Revision

Practice writing the Arabic alphabet. The assessment criteria will be that the child must be able to write the Arabic letter when prompted.

Part 2 – Revision

A special focus on how to join letters to form words. The vocabulary that is used in the Arabic lessons can be used for the writing practice. This will be a revision of the vocabulary in addition to the writing practice. Ashkalul-Huroof to be used as the teacher feels necessary or to set homework.

Part 3

The revision of the above must be completed by Eid-ul-Adha. After Eid-ul-Adha there must be a special focus on writing sentences. These sentences must be part of the Arabic work being covered in Level 3.

Arabic vocabulary – Part 1

The following vocabulary needs to be revised within 3 months.

1. Numbers (1 to 10).
2. Numbers (just 10's – up to 100).
3. Fruits & vegetables.
4. Colours.
5. Shapes
6. Names of family members.
7. Simple body parts.
8. Names of the months.
9. Simple everyday phrases.

Arabic vocabulary – Part 2

Notes on Arabic:

1. The above 3 items must be covered after the relevant revision.
2. Each item needs to be covered in the above order using the material in the revision booklet.
3. After completing all 3 items once, they need to be covered again twice (as a new Sabaq to ensure children grasp the concepts) Hence, all items will be covered three times throughout the year.
4. Give out worksheets so that children practice writing and applying their knowledge.
5. Arabic must be covered twice a week for 20 to 25 minutes. Once a week is not sufficient in terms of maintaining continuity.
