

# *Madrasa Tajweedul Quran*

## Level 6 – Quran, Tajweed & Surats

### First and foremost:

Complete revision of all Tajweed rules within the first week of Madrasa. Quran Sabaq can start from the first day, but at a slow pace. *The revision and understanding of Tajweed rules is essential.*

### Quran:

1. Five Siparas to be completed this year.
2. Starting from the 13<sup>th</sup> Juz till the end of the 17<sup>th</sup> Juz.
3. The average number of lines per day will be 14.5. *Refer to the L.T.P. for the annual breakdown.*

### Notes on Quran:

1. Level 6 will only be covering the Quran for **four** days per week. The other two days will be spent on Arabic. Despite only 3 days being allocated for the Quran, the class at this level must be capable of reciting fluently due to their age and the effort of the previous
2. The challenge in Level 6 is to get the children to excel upon reciting with a tune and reciting in longer breaths. Teacher need to be a role model for this and constantly motivate their pupils.
3. It is not necessary to listen to the entire Sabaq of a pupil; each pupil can be made to recite 5 or 6 lines.
4. At no point must the level of Tajweed and fluency “drop”. This usually occurs when teachers become “relaxed” and complacent. It is essential pupils are constantly asked questions relating to Tajweed.

### Tajweed Rules:

In addition to the revision carried out in the first week, there must be adhoc testing of Tajweed rules in the Quran Sabaq on a weekly basis.

## Surats to be memorised:

First revise the following:

1. Al-Fatiha
2. Al-Ikhlās
3. Al-Kauthar
4. Al-Asr
5. An-Naas
6. Al Falaq
7. Al Lahab
8. AN Nasr
9. Al Kaafiroon
10. Al Maa'oon
11. Al Quraysh
12. Al Feel
13. Al Lumazah
14. Al Takathur
15. Al qaria'h
16. Wal Aadiyaat
17. AZ zilzaal
18. Al Qadr
19. Wat Teen
20. Alam Nashrah
21. Wadhuhaa

Then:

1. Surat-ul-Yasin – up to verse 44.
1. ***Note: Memorisation of Surat-ul-Yasin must commence after Eid-ul-Adha. It is entirely optional to memorise this. This will ensure time is not consumed in chasing pupils for this.*** Please ensure a letter is sent out to parents prior to starting this Surah.
2. ***The 21 Surats listed above for revision must be revised throughout the year and must not be compromised (a timetable must be prepared and given to all pupils).***

# *Madrasa Tajweedul Quran*

## Notes on Surats to be memorised:

1. Surat-ul-Yasin needs to be spread out over 3 or 4 months.
2. These need to be distributed evenly throughout the year.
3. Surats must be recited slowly and with Tajweed.
4. The teacher must recite each Surat regularly so that children adapt to the correct recitation and (as an optional extra) the tune.
5. A slip must be sent to parents via the homework diary every time a new Surat is started.
6. When children have school holidays, teachers must take advantage of this and utilise the extra time children have at home.
7. A revision timetable must be in place and regularly updated. *The teacher needs to ensure Surats are listened to everyday.*
