



Sanatayn Year 2 (Girls) – Quran, Tajweed, Surats & Fahmul Quran

1. Quran:

First and foremost:

- Complete revision of all Tajweed rules within the first few weeks of Madrasah. Refer to the LTP.
- Quran Sabaq can start from the first day, but at a slow pace, then increase in terms of number of lines. *The revision and understanding of Tajweed rules is essential.*

Then:

1. Four Siparas to be completed this year.
2. Starting from half of 23rd Juz till the end of the 26th Juz – 4 Juz.
3. *Refer to the L.T.P. for the annual breakdown.*
4. *Quran and Tajweed theory will only be covered 2 days a week. The other one day will be devoted to Fahmul Quran.*

Notes:

1. Refer to the “Notes on Quran” section of the syllabus. The guidance mentioned is important and teachers are to implement these guidelines.
2. A lot of emphasis needs to be given to C.L.S.T; the recitation of all children must be clear, loud and slow with Tajweed. Pupils must be reciting fluently.
3. There must be a special focus on tune from the beginning of the year and **pupils should be moulded into reciting in one style and tune**. The teacher must be a role model for this.
4. At no point must the level of Tajweed and fluency “drop”. This usually occurs when teachers become “relaxed” and complacent. It is essential pupils are constantly asked questions relating to Tajweed and errors pointed out.
5. Pupils must recite *a minimum of one line* in one breath (according to the 13 line Quran).

Sajdah Tilaawah:

- It is the responsibility of the Quran teacher to revise this handout once again (as a follow up from Level 7) when Sajdah Tilawah appears.
- A handout of this is included in the Supplementary Booklet.

2. Tajweed:

1. No new Tajweed rules to be covered from this year.
2. Within the first few weeks, all the rules from Levels 1 to 4 need to be explained and revised. (Refer to the LTP).
3. Emphasis needs to be on practical implementation and pupils must be tested on Tajweed rules randomly and on a regular basis. There must be practical implementation of all Tajweed rules.

Pupils must also be able to confidently explain the various Tajweed rules as per the booklet “Explaining Tajweed Rules”. Ask for a copy if unsure.

4. Revision of the following also needs to take place:

- Understanding Makharij
- Mudood
- Isti'azah & Basmalah
- Lahn (Khafi and Jali)

Pupils must fully understand and be able to explain all the above as per the guidance mentioned in the booklet. This will form part of the oral assessments.

Note: All Tajweed theory, Makharij etc must be revised throughout the year.

3. Surats:

No new Surats to be memorised. Thorough revision must be done of all Surats covered.

Notes:

Refer to the “Notes on Surats” section of “Memorising & Understanding Short Surahs”. The guidance mentioned is important and teachers are to implement these guidelines.

4. Fah-mul Quran:

To enrich and expand Quranic studies, two element of Fah-mul Quran is introduced in the syllabus.

Element 1:

Over the course of the year, the teacher should cover at the least eight places from the Quran syllabus where the following is done:

- 1) Brief Tafseer is covered with the pupils of a particular Sabaq they are covering. This can entail translation, background of the verse etc.
- 2) Pupils can be given an “extended learning” task to find out and do research about a particular verse.

The aim of this is to create a love of the message of the Quran in the hearts of our pupils.

Element 2 - Tafseer of Surahs:

After revising the Surahs covered previously, the teacher must cover the Tafseer of the following from *Memorising & Understanding Short Surahs*:

	Name of Surah
1	Duha
2	Inshirah
3	Tin
4	Alaq (optional)
5	Bayyinah (optional)

1. Pupils must memorise the translation of each Surah
2. In addition to this, pupils must also be able to recall and explain the following:
 - ✓ Cause of revelation of the Surah – if applicable.
 - ✓ Link the key events of each Surah with the Surah.
 - ✓ The background of each Surah.
 - ✓ Explain the meaning of each verse as explained in the booklet. (This is different to the translation).
 - ✓ Answer any questions relating to the Surah according to the information given in the book.
 - ✓ List any lessons learned from the Surah.
3. Pupils will be assessed on this via a written test.
4. Please refer to the LTP for a breakdown of how to complete these Surahs.
5. *When this part of the syllabus commences, one day a week will need to be devoted for this. On this day, the teacher will only listen to Surahs.*
6. **Revision of Surahs covered already must continue with new Surahs.**
7. *Refer to further guidance in “Memorising & Understanding Short Surahs”.*

Advised Timetable:

- The following timetable is advised.
- This will ensure all items mentioned in the class syllabus are completed.
- Surah and Tajweed revision is completed in 2 week cycles.
- The teacher may need to tweak the timetable as the year progresses.

5. Tarbiyah Topics:

- Every week, 15 minutes should be devoted to a Tarbiyah Topic or similar. The topic can range from current affairs to more spiritual matters. It can also take the form of a Q & A.
- These topics needs to be covered in an interactive manner, with discussion and participation from pupils.
- The following book is advised: *The war within our Hearts by Habeeb Quadri and Sa'ad Quadri*. The teacher will pick topics from here and discuss these with the class.
- As part of Tarbiyah, the teacher can also arrange various physical activities such as, walking, cycling and sport. Also, activities such as, helping in the community, contributions to food bank, orphan sponsor for the year
- ***Please see the deputy head in relation to this.***
